



RYANAIR OPENS 3 AIRCRAFT BASE AND ANNOUNCES ITS BIGGEST EVER WINTER SCHEDULE AT LANZAROTE AIRPORT FOR WINTER 23/24

Ryanair, Spain's No.1 airline, today (11 Oct) announced the opening of its new Lanzarote base and biggest ever schedule for Winter 23/24 with 40 routes, including 6 new routes to Belfast, Bremen, Knock, Milan, Nuremberg and Zagreb, and increased frequencies on another 9 city break routes, including Dublin, Berlin, Madrid, and Vienna. This robust schedule offers Lanzarote customers/visitors unbeatable route choice at the lowest fares when booking their Winter breaks, while driving invaluable year-round tourism to Lanzarote, which depends on connectivity and tourism as an island-based economy.

To support this record schedule, Ryanair will base 3 aircraft at Lanzarote Airport this winter, representing a \$300m investment and supporting over 1,600 jobs.

Ryanair's Lanzarote Winter 23/24 schedule delivers:

- 3 base aircraft (\$300 million investment in Lanzarote)
- 40 routes, 6 new to Belfast, Bremen, Milan, Knock, Nuremberg & Zagreb
- Increased frequencies on 9 routes, including Dublin, Berlin, Madrid & Vienna
- Supporting 1,600 jobs, including 120 highly paid aviation jobs
- Lanzarote traffic to grow to 2.1m passengers p.a. in FY24

This significant investment demonstrates Ryanair's commitment to Lanzarote and continued confidence in the Spanish market, which is a direct result of the airline's close working relationships with key stakeholders in Spain. Ryanair is committed to grow and develop further in the Canaries through continued collaboration with associated airports, the Govt, the hospitality industry and local tourist organisations to improve the existing Canaries incentives and make the islands an even more attractive destination to airlines while boosting the local economy.

Ryanair is Spain's No.1 airline, operating over 545 routes this Winter and carrying over 54m passengers p.a. to/from Spain on its fleet of 76 Spain-based aircraft (\$7.6bn investment), driving year-round connectivity and inbound tourism which supports over 300,000 Spanish jobs and contributes over €14.66bn p.a. to Spanish GDP, equivalent to 1.2% of Spain's GDP.

To celebrate Ryanair's new Lanzarote base for Winter 23/24 and the launch of its biggest ever Winter schedule, the airline is offering fares from just €29.99, available only on the Ryanair website and app.
